Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit four Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay 1) \$29,217.50, and 2) separate authority to pay \$62,350.00, and 3) separate authority to pay \$46,110.00, and 4) separate authority to pay \$26,245.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for Melvin Megee.

DISCUSSION:


Melvin Megee has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on December 18, 2018, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of four Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Melvin Megee, based upon 1) a 25 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 2) a 42 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 3) a 34 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 4) a 23 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
