**2017**: WNOC receives Congressional recognition as the nation's most effective Food Recovery & Food Waste Reduction Model


**2019**: Recognized by CalRecycle as an Edible Food Recovery Model Practice






#### INNOVATION: Food Insecurity Screening

- 3. Connects donors and pantries


#### **INNOVATION:**

#### Food Recovery Kitchen Network

- 60,000 meals per week
- Culinary job training



#### Portable Cold Storage



- Cold storage/logistics solution.
- Hub to receive food in outlying area that is furthest away from food banks.
- Self contained, carbon neutral.
- Solar conversion technical training program.

- Provide inventory of Vacuum Sealed Nutritious Meals
- Maintain Number,
   Type and Location of

- After 6 months, meals are donated to NPO Pantries.
