DISCUSSION

The attached amendment to Ordinance C-6496, relating to the departmental organization of the City of Long Beach, incorporates some additional changes to City departments, bureaus, and divisions as listed on the attached summary for Fiscal Year 2007 (FY 07). These organizational changes are necessary to implement emergent operational needs that have arisen since the adoption of the FY 07 Budget.

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. C-6496, adopted July 5, 1988, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
