HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution directing the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller to include, on the 2007-08 Secured Tax Roll, certain levies made pursuant to the provisions of the Long Beach Municipal Code for weed and/or debris removal in the amount of \$6,869.05. (Districts 1 & 5)

DISCUSSION

Chapter 8.56 of the Long Beach Municipal Code sets forth procedures for notifying property owners to clean their vacant lots of weeds and/or debris. If the owner fails to remove the weeds or debris within the time stated following notification, or if appealed by order of the Board of Examiners, Appeals and Condemnation (BEAC), the City is authorized to clean the lot and assess a levy.

The City Code Enforcement Division's Building Official computes and records costs of removing weeds and/or debris from each parcel. Property owners are notified to pay these expenses. The owner may appeal the charges within 15 days of the bill. If the amount, as determined by the BEAC, is not paid within 30 days, the bill becomes delinquent and interest begins to accrue.

The attached Resolution allows the City to collect delinquent weed removal charges, incidental enforcement costs, interest, and a lien transfer charge from the owners through their property tax bills for properties cleaned during July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007. Interest accrues at the rate of 12 percent from the delinquency date through June 30, 2007.

Upon approval by the City Council, the Director of Financial Management will forward the authorizing Resolution and the prescribed reporting forms to the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller, Tax Division, for incorporation into the 2007-08 County Secured Tax Roll.

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This matter was reviewed by Assistant City Attorney Michael J. Mais on June 27, 2007, and Budget and Performance Management Bureau Manager David Wodynski on June 28, 2007.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this item is requested on July 10, 2007, as the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller requires receipt of the authorized lien assessment on July 31, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT

Cleaning charges and interest in the amount of \$6,869.05 were levied against the two listed properties (Exhibit A of Resolution). The County will be requested to collect these costs with the annual property taxes for deposit into the General Fund (GP). These revenues are used for code enforcement related activities undertaken by the Code Enforcement Division in the Department of Community Development (CD).

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH DIRECTING THE LOS ANGELES
COUNTY AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO INCLUDE ON THE
2007-2008 REAL AND SECURED TAX ROLL CERTAIN
ASSESSMENTS MADE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS
OF THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE FOR REMOVING
WEEDS AND DEBRIS (LOT CLEANING CHARGES)

WHEREAS, Section 8.56 of the Long Beach Municipal Code provides a system for levy and collection to cover the cost of removing weeds and debris by the City from privately owned real property; and

WHEREAS, the City's Building Official is required to certify to the City

Treasurer-Tax Collector the amount of the unpaid lot cleaning charges and interest for delinquency; and

WHEREAS, the City's Building Official has certified to the City Treasurer-Tax Collector unpaid lot cleaning charges and interest for delinquency which should be entered upon the real and secured tax roll;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The County Auditor-Controller be, and he is hereby authorized and requested to include on the 2007-2008 real and secured tax roll the delinquent assessment charges, and penalties, if any, for each of the described pieces of property set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. The county parcel number and the total unpaid assessment, together with interest thereon, and the situs address of the property is set forth in Exhibit "A." Only the amount set forth in the third column entitled "Amount" should be entered as charges due the City of Long Beach on
