HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract and any amendments thereto with M&M Lifts, Inc., for the purchase of one aerial lift truck on the same terms and conditions afforded the City of Corona in the total amount not to exceed \$96,805 including tax, with the option to purchase additional units, plus a 10 percent contingency if necessary and if funds are available. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

City Council approval is being requested authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract for the purchase of one (1) aerial lift truck for the Public Works, Street Maintenance, Street Tree Division.

The Public Works, Street Maintenance, Street Tree Division is currently utilizing one small aerial lift truck that is now past its useful life and is creating excessive inefficiencies. The current aerial lift truck to be replaced is 11 years old and was originally on a scheduled nine year life cycle. This aerial lift truck is part of the FY 08 replacement plan, as approved by the Fleet Review Committee.

The new aerial lift will be mounted on a Ford F-550 chassis with a gasoline powered engine rather than diesel, which will meet AQMD requirements for this classification. The possibility of other alternative fuel options was researched and found not to be a viable option for this configuration and usage.

The City Charter provides an alternative procurement method by permitting the City to purchase or otherwise obtain services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other governmental agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by a Resolution of the City Council.

The Department of Public Works, Fleet Services Bureau, investigated procurement options and learned that the City of Corona had completed a competitive bid process for aerial lift trucks and has a contract with M&M Lifts, Inc., that meets the City's needs. This cooperative purchase agreement will facilitate the timely acquisition of the aerial lift truck and provide cost benefits to the City.

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M&M Lifts, Inc., has agreed to sell one aerial lift truck to the City of Long Beach under the same terms and conditions as are afforded to the City of Corona in an amount not to exceed \$96,805 including tax, with the option to purchase additional units, plus a 10 percent contingency, if necessary and if funds are available. The Matrix Fleet Review Study also supports the use of cooperative purchase agreements and adherence to a long-term replacement plan. M&M Lifts, Inc., is a Minority-owned Business Enterprise (MBE).

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Lori A. Conway on January 7, 2008 and Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on January 10, 2008.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action to adopt the attached Resolution is requested on January 22, 2008 to ensure that the contract is in place expeditiously to minimize delivery turnaround time.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of this contract is \$96,805, including tax, and is budgeted in the Fleet Services Fund (IS 386) in the Department of Public Works (PW). The City will have the option of purchasing additional units, and adding expenditures up to 10 percent (or \$9,681) above the contract amount.

	26	Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated		
	27	herein by this reference.		
	28	Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an		
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agreement and amendments thereto with M & M Lifts, Inc. to purchase one (1) aerial lift
truck, with the option to purchase additional units, of substantially the same type and kind
purchased by the City of Corona pursuant to the Corona Purchase Order except as
modified by mutual agreement of the City and M & M Lifts, Inc., and the purchase by the
City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Corona in an
amount not to exceed \$96,805.16, including tax, with a 10% contingency for additional
equipment, for a period extending until the warranty on the aerial lift truck expires.

8 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
9 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
