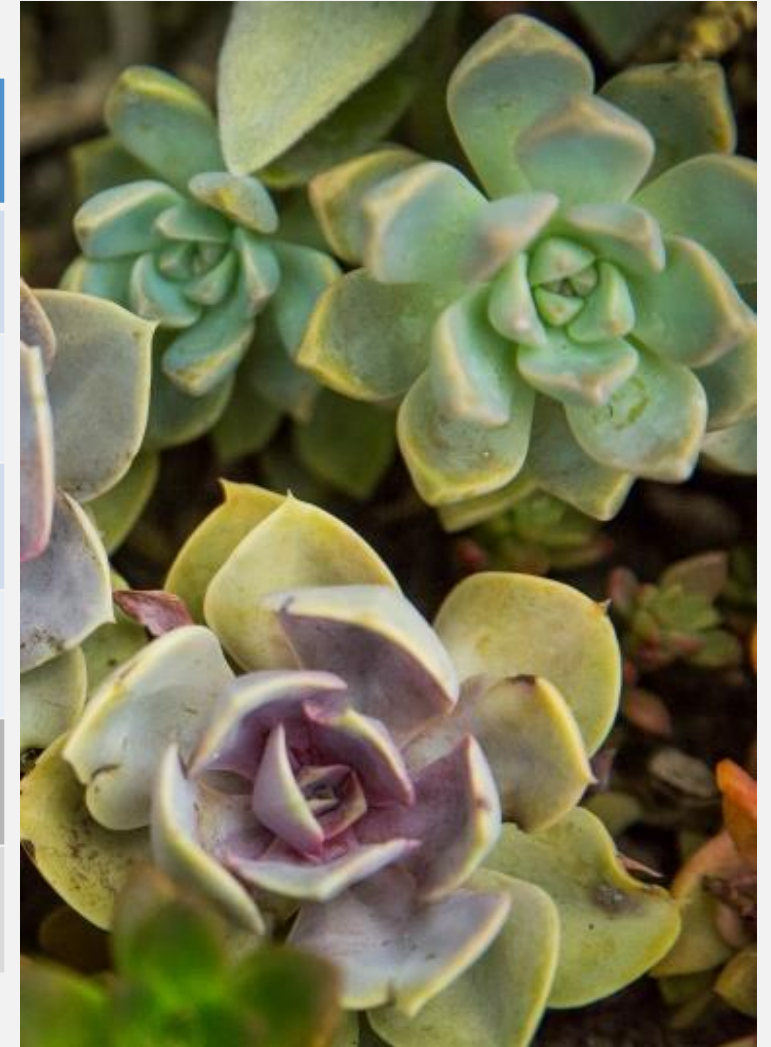

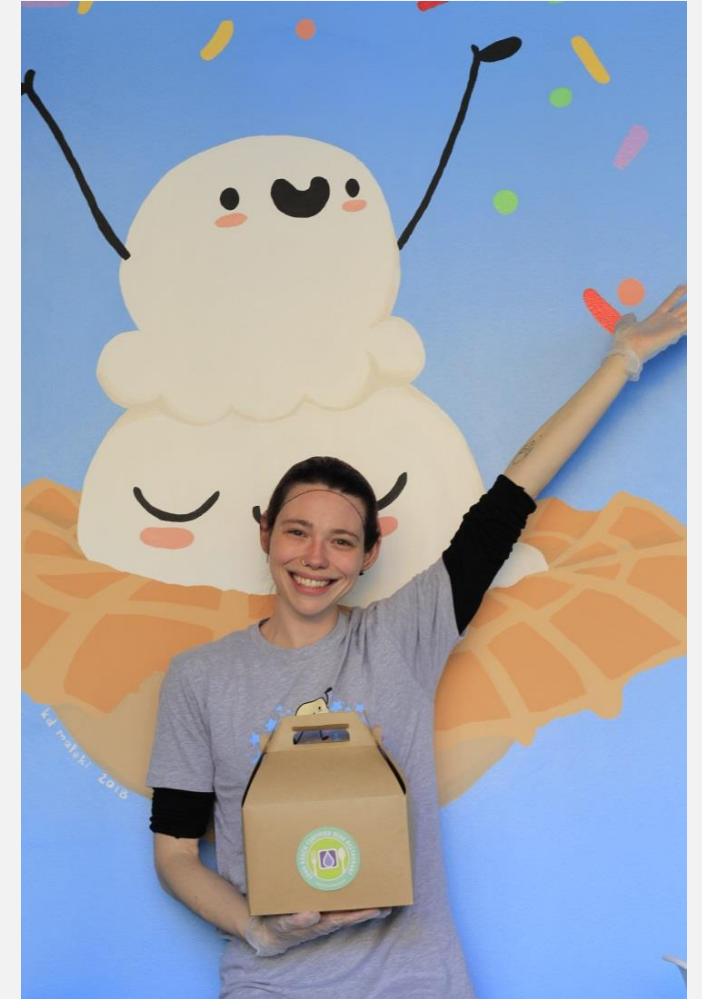
Lawn to Garden Changes (Pending)

	2018	April 1, 2019
Number of Applications	Capped at 150	Open
Incentive - Front yard	\$3 per sqft	\$3 per sqft
Incentive - Back yard	Not incentivized	\$2 per sqft
Max Area - Residential	1,500 sqft	5,000 sqft
Incentive - Commercial	\$1 per sqft	\$2 per sqft
Max Area - Commercial	10,000 sqft	50,000 sqft



Certified Blue Restaurant Program

- Recognize restaurants for water efficiency
 - Free on site survey for all applicants
 - Free devices and rebates offered
 - 48 restaurants certified
- Cross-promotion of Green Business Program
- Planning to expand to hotels
