Re: Proposition 8

Dear Mayor and Council members:

The Gay and Lesbian Community Center of Greater Long Beach provides services to support, inform and connect the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities through programs of information and education, health and well-being, cultural and social activities, and social justice. We advocate for the inclusion of all individuals into a free and just community, without judgment or restriction due to sexual orientation or gender expression.

We stand in solidarity with the Human Relations Commission in requesting that the City Council adopt a resolution affirming Chief Judge Vaughn Walker's ruling in Perry v. Schwarzenegger wherein Proposition 8 was found to violate the Equal Protection and Due Process rights of California's same-sex couples. We also request that the city facilitate the granting of marriage licenses to same-sex couples if the stay is lifted.

We cannot stay silent. By speaking out together for social justice, we continue to advocate that lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people are not second class citizens. By speaking out together for equality, we continue to give hope to those at risk of being bullied, harassed and/or physically mistreated for being gay. By speaking out together for fundamental rights for all people, we continue to form a more perfect and unshakeable union. We therefore ask the City Council to join us in supporting the assertion - gays, lesbians, bisexual and transgender people are not forsaken under the United States Constitution and that they deserve to have the same rights and recognition for their loving relationships as opposite-sex couples do.
