RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term Permit, with conditions on the application of Michoacan Entertainment, a California corporation, DBA Copa Cabana Night Club, 2688 East South Street, for Entertainment With Dancing by Patrons at an existing Restaurant. (District 8)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term permit shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

Attached for your review is the application from Michoacan Entertainment, a California corporation, DBA Copa Cabana Night Club. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved for a One-Year Short-Term permit subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets Department requirements for the proposed use.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets Department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets Department requirements for the proposed use.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant with alcohol since November 1974.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Burton on October 18, 2010.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of November 9, 2010, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT



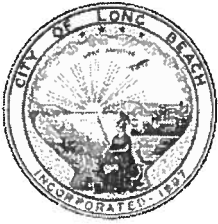

Application for Entertainment with Dancing

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Department of Financial Management recommends **approval of a One-Year Short-Term Permit subject to the following conditions:**

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities shall be restricted to between the hours of **4:00 PM to 12:00 AM** Monday through Thursday, **4:00 PM to 2:00 AM** Friday through Saturday, and **4:00 PM to 1:00 AM** Sunday.
- 4) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 5) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. **Sound shall not be audible within twenty feet (20') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.**
- 6) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 7) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 8) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard.

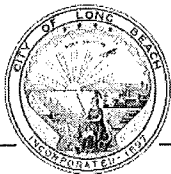
For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Copa Cabana employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.

- 9) In addition to the above security requirements, the permittee shall staff one (1) security guard in the parking lot between the hours of 10 p.m. and ½ hour after closing. The security guard shall ensure that patrons do not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. They shall also ensure the patrons enter and leave the parking lot in a peaceful manner as not to disturb any neighboring businesses or residents who live nearby. The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based on calls-for-service related to problems in the parking lot.
- 10) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 11) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 12) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 13) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 14) Copa Cabana, its promoters, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 15) All independent contractors and promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 16) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system to assist with monitoring the property. The permittee shall contact the Long Beach Police Department for a copy of the Video Surveillance System Guidelines for guidance

on camera location and equipment specifications. Recordings shall be retained for no less than 10 days.

- 17) The permittee shall maintain security cameras at all entrances and facades of the building. Recorded video shall be viewable upon request.
- 18) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
- 19) The permittee must submit an application for the renewal of the entertainment with dancing permit not later than July 2011 or four (4) months prior to the One-Year Short-Term permit expiration date.
- 20) There shall be no live entertainment or dancing permitted on the patio at any time.
- 21) The use of any amplifying system or device is prohibited on the patio, and the use of any such system or device inside the premises shall not be audible outside the premises.
- 22) There shall be no amusement machines, video game devices, dart games or pool tables maintained upon the patio at any time.
- 23) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

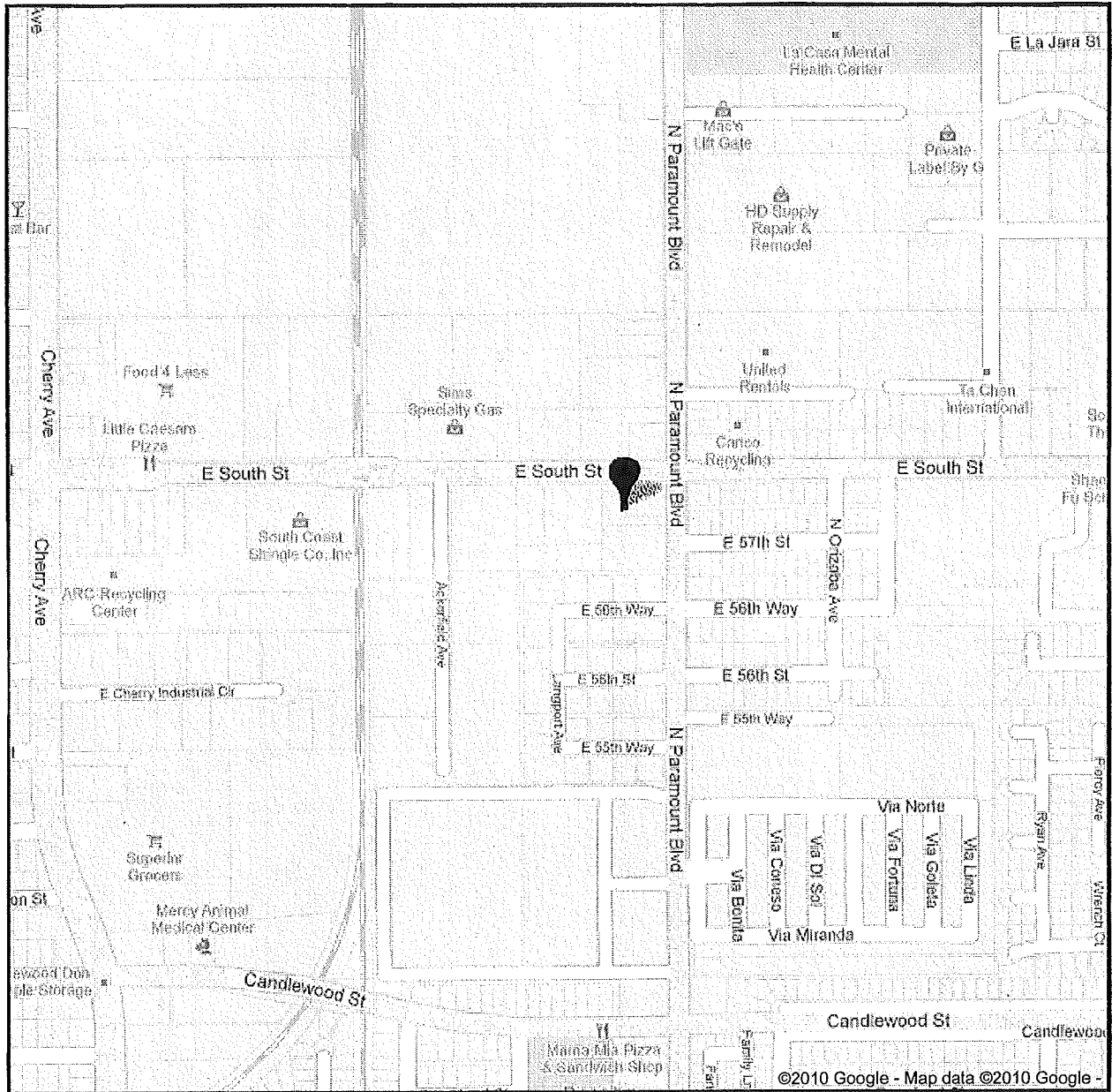

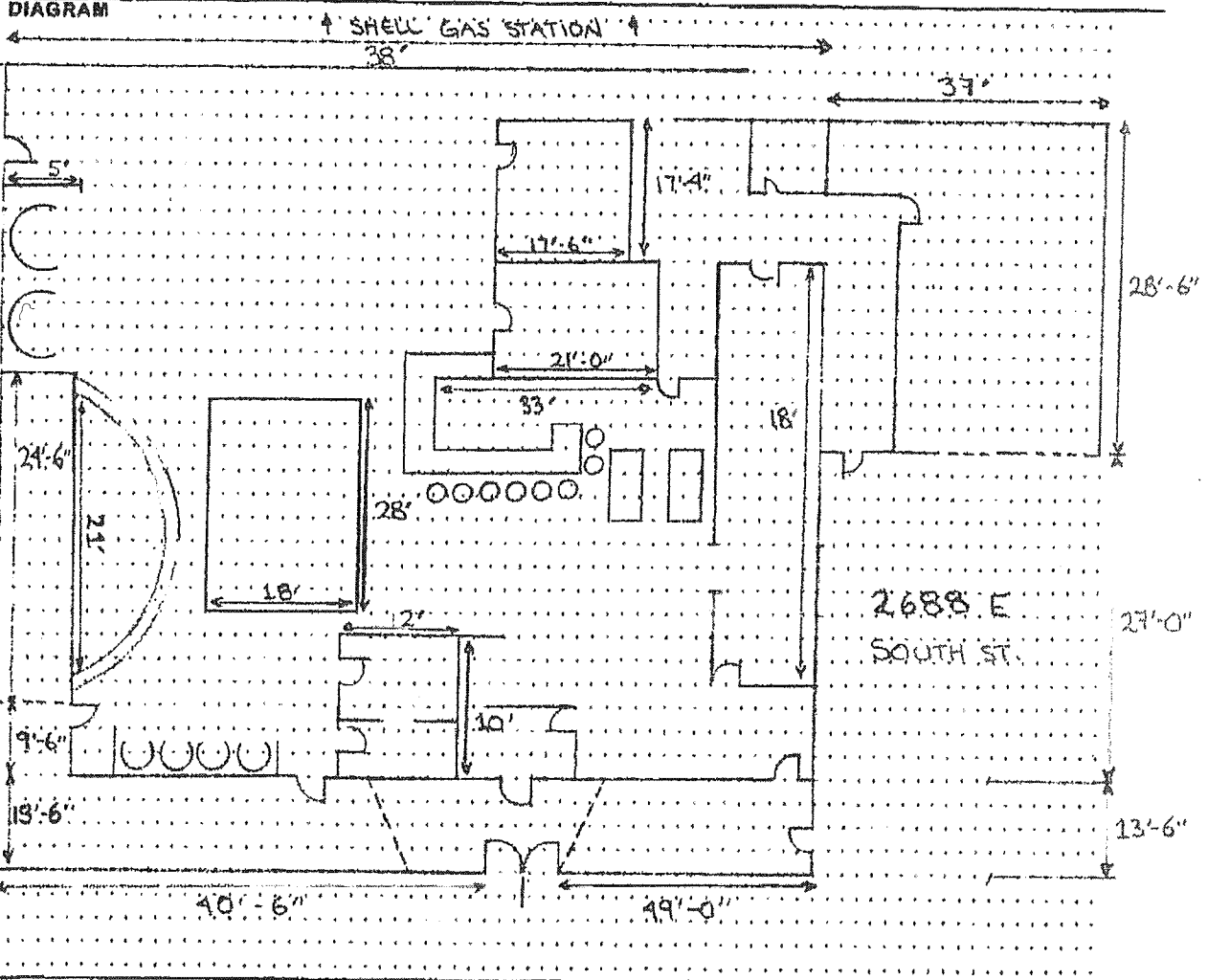



In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of a **One-Year Short-Term** permit, subject to the following seventeen (17) conditions of operation:

The Copa Cabana is a bar/night club located on the southwest corner of South Street and Paramount Avenue. The business has been in operation since 2006 and has had an Entertainment with Dancing Permit. The business was recently sold to Michoacan Entertainment A California Corporation, dba Copa Cabana Night Club. The business is owned and operated by Maria DeGuzman, who holds a Type 48 (On Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. On May 20, 2010, Copa Cabana applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit requesting live amplified music, karaoke, and a disc jockey.

Based upon the Long Beach Police Department's investigation, and the pending change of ownership, the Long Beach Police Department believes a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment with Dancing Permit would be in the best interests of the surrounding community and the City of Long Beach.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to, between the hours of **4:00 PM** and **2:00 AM** each day of the week.

- 4) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 5) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. **Sound shall not be audible within fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.**
- 6) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 7) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 8) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Copa Cabana employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 9) In addition to the above security requirements, the permittee shall staff one (1) security guard in the parking lot between the hours of 10 p.m. and ½ hour after closing. The security guard shall ensure that patrons do not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. They shall also ensure the patrons enter and leave the parking lot in a peaceful manner as not to disturb any neighboring businesses or residents who live nearby. The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based on calls-for-service related to problems in the parking lot.
- 10) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 11) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.

- 12) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 13) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 14) Copa Cabana, its promoters, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 15) All independent contractors and promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 16) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 17) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
