RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to declare ordinance correcting the description of the Court before which persons who have been arrested must appear read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading.

DISCUSSION

This office has prepared and submits the above-described ordinance for your consideration. Section 1.32.030(C)(1) of the Long Beach Municipal Code currently provides that persons who have been arrested for an alleged violation of the Code be given notice to appear before a judge "in a division of the municipal court". The Long Beach Courthouse is now a division of the Los Angeles County Superior Court rather than a municipal court, and the attached ordinance reflects that change.
