## FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 35249

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THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 35249 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of February 7, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on April 23, 2019, by and between SULLY-MILLER CONTRACTING COMPANY, a Delaware corporation ("Contractor"), whose address is 135 S. State College Blvd., Suite 400, Brea, California 92821, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Contract No. 35249 (the "Contract") whereby Contractor agreed to provide as-needed major and secondary highway construction services, as described in Project Plans and Specifications No. R-7131; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term one (1) additional one year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 4 of the Contract is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "4. <u>TIME FOR CONTRACT</u>. The term of this Contract shall commence at midnight on May 1, 2019, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2021, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Contract, or unless the services or the Project is completed sooner. The Parties have the option to extend the term one (1) additional one-year period. Time is of the essence hereunder. City will suffer damage if the work is not completed within the time stated, but those damages would be difficult or impractical to determine. So, Contractor shall pay to City, as liquidated damages, the amount stated in the Contract Documents."
- 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions in Contract No. 35249 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain if full force and effect.
