A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE WILDLIFE PROTECTION ACT OF 1990 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HABITAT ADJACENT TO A WALKING PATH IN THE WEST SAN GABRIEL RIVER PARKWAY

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Wildlife Protection Act of 1990, which provides funds to the State of California for grants to local agencies to acquire and/or develop facilities for public recreational and fish and wildlife habitat protection purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation ("Department") has been delegated with the responsibility for the administration of a portion of the program, including the establishment of necessary procedures for applications by local agencies; and

WHEREAS, these procedures require that the applicant certify by resolution the approval of application(s) before its submission to the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to submit an application for funding under the Habitat Conservation Fund Program of the Act ("Program") for the development of habitat adjacent to a walking path in the West San Gabriel River Parkway ("Project").

6 prior to commencement of any work on the project, the required match of funds.

7 Sec. 4. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have sufficient
8 funds to operate and maintain the project after it is completed.

9 Sec. 5. The City of Long Beach certifies that it understands the
10 assurances and certification in the application.

11 Sec. 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by
12 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this Resolution.
