## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the daytime curfew for minors read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading.

## DISCUSSION

This office has prepared and submits the above-described ordinance for your consideration. Section 9.58.020 of the Long Beach Municipal Code imposes a daytime curfew on minors during school hours. Federal caselaw calls into question the enforceability of Section 9.58.020 as currently written. The attached ordinance amends the daytime curfew prohibition so that it complies with certain court-imposed requirements and therefore will be enforceable in the future.
