1                    FIFTY-FIRST AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

3                    THIS FIFTY-FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made and  
4 entered, in duplicate, as of August 24, 2018 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a  
5 minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on  
6 November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation  
7 ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and  
8 the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

9                    WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby  
10 CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

11                    WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could  
12 choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

13                    WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided  
14 in the Contract;

15                    NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and  
16 conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as  
17 follows:

18                    1.        Section 81 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as  
19 follows:

20                    "81.    HANG FESTOON LIGHTING ON NORSE WAY.

21                    81.1    Scope of Work. WS shall install festoon lighting on Norse Way, more  
22 particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "CCC" and incorporated  
23 herein.

24                    81.2    Compensation. For the services and work related to installing festoon  
25 lighting on Norse Way, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not  
26 to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$25,995).

27                    81.3    Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions  
28 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,

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1 shall apply to installing festoon lighting on Norse Way."

2 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions  
3 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and  
4 confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.


5 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this document to be duly  
6 executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.

**RE: Norse Way Festoon Lighting**

Mr. King,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install festoon lighting on Norse Way as described below.

CLP will install eleven (11) spans of aircraft cable, festoon lighting strands with suspended sockets and T-50 LED bulbs from an existing street light on the corner of Norse Way and Lakewood Blvd. to the last street light near the intersection of Norse Way and Carson St. Once the installation is complete, CLP will energize the lights to ensure all the lamps are illuminated and working properly.

The existing street light circuit is 240V and the festoon lights require 120V. In order to supply the proper voltage, CLP will install three (3) stepdown transformers and three (3) receptacles to pull power from the existing LS-3, metered service.

Total cost for this work is **Twenty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$25,995).**

**Exceptions & Notes:**

1. Pricing is valid for 30-days.
2. Festival lights will be running off of a LS-3, metered street light service.
3. Maintenance of festoon lights is not included in this proposal.
