Dear Sir or Madam:

At its meeting of May 18, 2004, the City Council approved your application for a permit for entertainment without dancing by patrons at 200 Pine Avenue #C, Long Beach, CA 90802. The entertainment activities and entertainment hours from page 7 of the Entertainment Application (attached) were approved with the following conditions:

1. The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities expressly indicated on the permit of the application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
2. Live entertainment shall be limited to karaoke only. There shall be no disc jockey, live amplified music, or dancing by performers. This is consistent with your ABC conditions.
3. There shall be no entertainment permitted on the patio at anytime. This is consistent with your ABC conditions.
4. Unless separately applied for, reviews and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
5. The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard from 5:00 pm to one half-hour (1/2) after closing. This is consistent with your ABC conditions. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, the permittee shall increase security as directed by the Chief of Police. Security services shall only be provided by a Private Patrol Operator, properly licensed by the State of California and the City of Long Beach.
6. The door(s) or windows shall be kept closed at all times during the operation of business, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) are not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door.


7. No sound shall be audible from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
8. The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, unto a dance/nightclub. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with regular dining or pre-planned banquet activities. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bona fide eating-place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
9. Entertainment shall not be offered any day that the restaurant is closed.
10. The premises shall be maintained as a full service restaurant providing an assortment of meals normally offered in such establishments. In the event that the restaurant ceases operations, the entertainment permit becomes null and void.
11. The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
12. If any noise, disturbance complaints, or trash left in the parking lot and surrounding area of the business can be attributed to the operation of said business, the Police Department can determine and impose requirements for security officer presence to routinely police and handle these problems.
13. All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governing this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those by promoters.
14. The permittee must provide all promoters hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operations.
15. Persons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter or remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion off the establishment has closed.
16. The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, and ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions.
17. The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80)

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In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions.
