

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0149

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LENCO INDUSTRIES, INC. TO PURCHASE A BEAR CAT ARMORED TACTICAL VEHICLE, THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$349,583, INCLUDING TAXES AND FEES

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a 2022 Lenco Bear Cat, including all needed communication equipment, ballistic windows and other accessories, offset by Urban Area Security Initiative 2020 grant funds; and

WHEREAS, this armored tactical unit will be used by the Police Department when special weapons response operations are needed and is replacing an older unit currently in the Police Department fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau and the Purchasing Division of the Financial Management Department researched procurement options for armored tactical response units and discovered other agencies had completed an open, fair, transparent, and competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, the City reviewed the cooperative agreement options and determined that the contract between the San Diego Unified Port District and Lenco Industries, Inc. provided the best value to the City; and

1 WHEREAS, Lenco Industries, Inc. was selected based on the best value
2 and competitive pricing for the armored tactical vehicle, as well Lenco Industries being a
3 well-known leader in manufacturing custom specialty vehicles; and

4 WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District has an agreement for the
5 purchase of these armored vehicles, Purchase Agreement No. 21-2021MA
6 (“Agreement/Contract/PO Number”); and

7 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the San Diego Unified Port District
8 Agreement will facilitate the City’s ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost
9 benefits to the City; and

10 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
11 participate in the San Diego Unified Port District Agreement, considerably more funds
12 would be required;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
14 follows:

15 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
16 herein by this reference.

17 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
18 an agreement with Lenco Industries, Inc. to purchase a Bear Cat armored tactical
19 vehicle, of the same type and kind identified in the San Diego Unified Port District
20 agreement except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Lenco Industries,
21 Inc., and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to
22 the San Diego Unified Port District in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty-Nine
23 Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$349,583) including taxes and fees.

24 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
25 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
