### **DISCUSSION:**

Roland Bell has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on October 2, 2007, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Roland Bell, based upon 1) a 70 percent disability rating, and 2) a further provision for a Life Pension at the rate of \$38.65 per week. Finally, there would be a provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
