A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACQUIRE THREE (3) WAYNE CURBTENDER AUTOMATED REFUSE TRUCKS, THROUGH THE PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO AND RAY GASKIN SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase three (3) Wayne Curbtender automated refuse trucks; and

WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento has a purchase order for the purchase of these refuse trucks from Ray Gaskin Service, PO Number PA80680329 ("County Purchase Order"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the County Purchase Order will facilitate acquisition of these refuse trucks as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the County Purchase Order considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
 - 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an

agreement with Ray Gaskin Service to purchase three (3) Wayne Curbtender automated
refuse trucks, of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the County of
Sacramento pursuant to the County Purchase Order, except as modified by mutual
agreement of the City and Ray Gaskin Service, and the purchase by the City shall be on
the same terms and conditions afforded to the County of Sacramento in an amount not to
exceed \$772,570.50, including tax, with a 10% contingency for additional equipment, for
a period extending until the warranty on the refuse trucks expires.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the
City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
