#### RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and deny the Entertainment Permit application of JAB Entertainment, Inc., DBA Sugarwalls, 1811 W. Anaheim Street, for an Entertainment Permit With Dancing by Performers at an existing restaurant. (District 1)

#### **DISCUSSION**

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before a license or permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the entertainment permit application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business and entertainment activities in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved; if not, it shall be denied.

Attached for your review is the entertainment permit application from JAB Entertainment, Inc., DBA Sugarwalls. Also attached are reports from various City departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the business license and entertainment permit history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by performers be denied. Based on the demonstrated, knowingly and consistent failure of the applicant to conduct the business and entertainment in accordance with local and state laws, the Police Department is unable to find that the public peace, safety and welfare will not be impaired if the permit is granted.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by performers be approved with conditions.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Zoning Section of the Planning and Building Department recommends that the
  permit for entertainment with dancing by performers be denied. Based on the
  information provided by the Police Department, this business is operating in such a
  manner that it would be defined as an adult entertainment use per Zoning code
  section 21.45.110.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant with alcohol since September 14, 2006, and was issued a one-hundred-twenty (120) day temporary entertainment permit on April 4, 2007.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on June 25, 2007.

#### TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of July 10, 2007, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail. JAB Entertainment, Inc., DBA Sugarwalls is operating on a temporary permit that expires on August 1, 2007.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Inspection \$290 and Zoning Review \$14 (Planning and Building Department), Police Investigation \$1,000 (Police Department), Temporary Permit \$300, Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$287.63 and Regulatory \$250 (Financial Management Department).



APPLICATION FOR ENTERTAINMENT WITHOUT DANCING BY PATRONS AT SUGARWALLS - 1811 WEST ANAHEIM STREET

The Police Department recommends **DENIAL** of the application for an Entertainment Without Dancing permit at Sugarwalls, located at 1811 West Anaheim Street. Our recommendation is based on the demonstrated, knowingly and consistent failure of the applicant to conduct the business in accordance with local and state laws.

#### **Background**

Sugarwalls, a for-profit corporation, Jab Entertainment, Inc., dba Sugarwalls, is a bikini bar/restaurant located on the north side of Anaheim Street between Cota and Seabright Avenues. The president and sole owner is listed as Melinda Garcia. On September 5, 2006, the City Council approved a type 47 (On Sale general eating place) Alcoholic Beverage license. On September 20, 2006, Sugarwalls was issued a conditional business license to operate a restaurant with alcohol, however, they did not apply for an entertainment permit at this time. On March 19, 2007, Sugarwalls applied for an Entertainment Without Dancing permit, which includes live amplified music, a disc jockey, and dancing by performers.

#### **Crime Analysis**

As part of the investigation, Vice detectives examined calls for service, crime reports and arrests at the above location for a two-year period between March 19, 2005 and March 19, 2007. The report revealed ten (10) calls for service, seven (7) incident reports, without any arrests attributable to the business. Five of the incidents were reports written by Vice detectives regarding illegal activity at the business. The remaining incidents were a battery that occurred in the parking lot, and a stabbing that also occurred in the parking lot. For further see crystal report analysis.

#### Patrol Division

West Division Patrol Commander Billy Quach was contacted for an opinion regarding the issuance of this permit. He said, to his knowledge, there have only been a few incidents at the location. He does not anticipate any significant impact on Patrol resources. Based on the calls for service and incidents, he has no objections to the issuance of the entertainment permit.

#### Vice Investigations

#### Administrative Investigation

On August 29, 2006, Detective Anderson met with both Melinda Garcia, the owner, and her husband Jorge Garcia, the manager, regarding permitted activities at the location. They advised that they had purchased the business, and were in the process of transferring the ABC license. They were advised that they were required to obtain a business license before they could operate, and an entertainment permit before they could provide entertainment.

On September 20, 2006, Sugarwalls was issued a conditional business license to operate a restaurant with alcohol; however, they did not apply for an entertainment permit at this time.

On December 9, 2006, Vice Detectives filed an incident report after observing Sugarwalls provide entertainment without a permit. A criminal complaint was filed by the City Prosecutors office, with the owner subsequently pleading guilty on February 28, 2007. On March 19, 2007, the owners of Sugarwalls applied for an entertainment permit.

#### Team Inspection Violations

On Thursday, March 22, 2007, a Team Inspection was conducted. Vice Detectives, along with representatives from the Fire Department, Building and Planning, and the Health Department, met with Jorge Garcia. During the inspection, Detective Anderson spoke with Jorge Garcia in depth about the type of entertainment he was planning, and what was permissible under local and state laws relative to bikini dancers. Mr. Garcia was also provided a printed explanation of permitted activities.

#### <u>Undercover Police Investigations</u>

As part of the investigation of this application, and on-going covert monitoring to ensure compliance, Vice detectives went to the location in an undercover capacity on four separate occasions over the past month.

On each of our visits, officers observed females dancing on stage wearing bikinis. While performing, the dancers openly exposed their bare breasts, nipples and areolas, in violation of local ordinance and state law. On one occasion, the activity was promoted by the disc jockey.

Detectives again on all three occasions, observed the dancers perform lapdances for patrons that consisted of simulated sexual intercourse and exposure of their breasts, nipples and areolas, and on one occasion, buttocks and anus, a violation of local ordinance and State law. Additionally, during one visit, one performer solicited a detective to purchase her an alcoholic beverage. (A violation of the Business and Professions code.) Anthony W. Throughout these visits, the illegal activities were openly committed in the presence of Sugarwalls employees who had a clear and unobstructed view without attempting to stop or control the behavior.

Based on the documented incidents and on-going investigation, four incident reports have been filed alleging the criminal activity. One female dancer was cited for un-permitted activities, and is due in court on August 21, 2007 to answer the charges. Detectives have also delivered the four incident reports to the department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for possible action against their license.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Based on the Police Department's investigation, we believe that the licensee has knowingly and consistently demonstrated a failure to conduct the business in accordance with local and State law. Therefore, the Police Department is unable to find that the public peace, safety and welfare will not be impaired if this permit is granted. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5.72 LBMC, the Police Department recommends that a permit for Entertainment Without Dancing at this location be **DENIED**.
