3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE
5 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS
6 ANGELES TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE
7 CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL
8 MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY,
9 NOVEMBER 2, 2010

11 WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Long
12 Beach, California on November 2, 2010; and

13 WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of these elections, it will be necessary
14 to mail sample ballots and polling place information to the registered voters of the City,
15 and it will facilitate such mailing if the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of
16 Los Angeles will make available to the City the computer record of the names and
17 addresses of all eligible registered voters in order that labels may be printed for attaching
18 to self-mailer sample ballot pamphlets; and

19 WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service shall be paid
20 by the City of Long Beach.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
23 follows:

24 Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the
25 Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of
26 Supervisors of the County to permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to provide all
27 services necessary for the lawful and effective conduct of the special election to be held
28 on November 2, 2010, and make available to the City additional assistance according to

1 state law.

2 Section 2. That the City shall reimburse the County for services
3 performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly
4 approved bill.

5 Section 3. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward without delay
6 to the Board of Supervisors and to the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, each a certified
7 copy of this resolution.

8 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
9 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
