A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE PINE AVENUE FROM 1ST STREET TO 3RD STREET FROM AUGUST 14, 2020 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2020, OR UNTIL THE SAFER AT HOME HEALTH ORDER FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19 CHANGES

WHEREAS, in an effort to support COVID-19 recovery for businesses and residents, the Long Beach City Council approved an Open Streets Initiative to temporarily transform public areas into safe spaces for physical-distanced activities; and

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of Pine Avenue between 1st Street and 3rd Street will add more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and provide for a stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical distancing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the closure of Pine Avenue between 1st Street and 3rd Street will add more open public space to allow for increased outdoor activities and provide for a stronger economic recovery, while maintaining appropriate physical distancing.

Section 2. For the period of August 14, 2020 through October 31, 2020, or until the Safer at Home Health Order for Control of COVID-19 changes, Pine Avenue from 1st Street to 3rd Street is hereby withdrawn and removed from public use.

Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to post notices of the intent to temporarily close Pine Avenue from 1st Street to 3rd Street
