RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit three Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay 1) \$1,995.00, 2) separate authority to pay \$45,950.00, and also 3) separate authority to pay \$22,050.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for **Joseph Bahash**.


DISCUSSION:

Joseph Bahash has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on April 14, 2009 approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Three Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Joseph Bahash, based upon 1) 4 3/4 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, 2) 42 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 3) a 24 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
