

SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM
SPONSOR/SITE AGREEMENT

1 THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 2, 2014
2 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of
3 the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on April 1, 2014, by and between the CITY OF
4 LONG BEACH ("Sponsor") and CALIFORNIA AQUATIC THERAPY AND WELLNESS
5 CENTER ("Site Organization"), whose address is 6801 Long Beach Blvd., Long Beach,
6 CA 90805.

7 WHEREAS, the California Department of Education ("CDE") has funds for a
8 2014 Summer Food Service Program for Children ("Program") to provide free meals to
9 eligible children; and

10 WHEREAS, Sponsor has executed or will soon execute an agreement with
11 a vendor to prepare the meals; and

12 WHEREAS, Site Organization rents, leases, owns, operates, maintains, or
13 otherwise controls a site, independent of Sponsor, located in or near the City of Long
14 Beach at which the meals could be served; and

15 WHEREAS, Site Organization desires to participate in the Program; and

16 WHEREAS, CDE requires that Sponsor enter a written agreement with
17 each Site Organization that participates in the Program;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions
19 herein, the parties agree as follows:

20 1. Site Organization shall serve lunch to all needy children 1 to 18 years of
21 age (or persons over 18 years of age if they are mentally or physically disabled and
22 participating in a public or private nonprofit school program for the mentally or physically
23 disabled), using Site Organization employees and volunteers, all of whom are subject to
24 the management, direction, and control of Site Organization.

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1 2. Sponsor shall provide to Site Organization, through Sponsor's vendor,
2 lunch as part of the Program. The number and type of meals to be provided shall depend
3 on the attendance reported to Sponsor by Site Organization on a daily basis.

4 3. Site Organization shall provide adequate supervision during the food
5 service, and shall report to Sponsor any and all problems concerning or related to the
6 food service.

7 4. Site Organization shall maintain and submit promptly such reports and
8 records as Sponsor requires.

9 5. Site Organization shall promptly report to Sponsor any change in the
10 number of meals required as attendance at Site Organization activities, programs,
11 classes and the like fluctuates. Such report is exempt from the notice provision set forth
12 in Section 17 hereof.

13 6. Site Organization and Sponsor shall comply with Title VI of the Civil
14 Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88-352) and all requirements imposed by the regulations of the
15 Department of Agriculture (7 CFR Part 15), Department of Justice (28 CFR Parts 42 &
16 50), and FNS directives or regulations issued pursuant to that Civil Rights Act to the
17 effect that no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, religion, color, sex,
18 sexual orientation, AIDS, AIDS related condition, age, national origin, disability, handicap,
19 or Vietnam Era veteran status, be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or
20 otherwise be subject to discrimination under any program or activity for which Site
21 Organization and Sponsor received Federal financial assistance from the Department of
22 Agriculture. And, Site Organization and Sponsor hereby give assurance that they shall
23 immediately take any measures necessary to effectuate compliance.

24 7. To the fullest extent permitted by California law, Site Organization shall
25 indemnify and hold harmless the City, its boards, commissions, and their officials,
26 employees and agents (collectively in this Section "City") from and against any and all
27 liability, claims, demands, damage, causes of action, proceedings, penalties, loss, costs,
28 and expenses (including attorney's fees, court costs, and expert and witness fees)

1 (collectively "Claims" or individually "Claim"). Claims include allegations and include by
2 way of example but are not limited to: Claims for property damage, personal injury or
3 death arising in whole or in part from any negligent act or omission of Site Organization,
4 its officers, employees, or agents, or anyone under Site Organization's control
5 (collectively "Indemnitor"); Site Organization's breach of this Agreement;
6 misrepresentation; willful misconduct; and Claims by any employee of Indemnitor relating
7 in any way to worker's compensation. Independent of the duty to indemnify and as a
8 free-standing duty on the part of Site Organization, Site Organization shall defend City
9 and shall continue such defense until the Claim is resolved, whether by settlement,
10 judgment or otherwise. Site Organization shall notify the City of any claim within ten (10)
11 days. Likewise, City shall notify Site Organization of any claim, shall tender the defense
12 of such claim to Site Organization, and shall assist Site Organization, as may be
13 reasonably requested, in such defense.

14 8. As a condition precedent to the effectiveness of this Agreement, Site
15 Organization shall procure and maintain at Site Organization's expense for the duration
16 of this Agreement from insurance companies that are admitted to write insurance in
17 California or from authorized non-admitted insurance companies that have ratings of or
18 equivalent to A:VIII by A.M. Best Company the following insurance:

19 (a) Commercial general liability insurance (equivalent in scope to ISO form
20 CG 00 01 11 85 or CG 00 01 11 88) in an amount not less than One Million Dollars
21 (\$1,000,000.00) per each occurrence and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00)
22 general aggregate. Such coverage shall include but not be limited to broad form
23 contractual liability, cross liability, independent contractors' liability, and products
24 and completed operations liability and shall not exclude claims alleging abuse or
25 molestation. The Sponsor, its officials, employees and agents shall be named as
26 additional insureds by endorsement (on Sponsor's endorsement form or on an
27 endorsement equivalent in scope to ISO form CG 20 26 11 85), and this insurance
28 shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection given to the Sponsor,

1 its officials, employees and agents.

2 (b) Workers' Compensation insurance as required by the Labor Code of the
3 State of California and employer's liability insurance in an amount not less than
4 One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

5 Any self-insurance program, self-insured retention, or deductible must be
6 separately approved in writing by City's Risk Manager or designee and shall protect
7 Sponsor, its officials, employees and agents in the same manner and to the same extent
8 as they would have been protected had the policy or policies not contained retention or
9 deductible provisions. Each insurance policy shall be endorsed to state that coverage
10 shall not be reduced, non-renewed or cancelled except after thirty (30) days prior written
11 notice to Sponsor, and shall be primary and not contributing to any other insurance or
12 self-insurance maintained by Sponsor. Site Organization shall notify the Sponsor in
13 writing within five (5) days after any insurance required herein has been voided by the
14 insurer or cancelled by the insured.

15 Site Organization shall require that all contractors and subcontractors which
16 Site Organization uses in the performance of services hereunder maintain insurance in
17 compliance with this Section unless otherwise agreed in writing by City's Risk Manager or
18 designee.

19 Site Organization shall deliver to Sponsor certificates of insurance and
20 required endorsements for approval as to sufficiency and form. The certificate and
21 endorsements for each insurance policy shall contain the original signature of a person
22 authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. In addition, Site Organization,
23 shall, within thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the insurance required herein, furnish to
24 Sponsor certificates of insurance and endorsements evidencing renewal of such
25 insurance. Sponsor reserves the right to require complete certified copies of all policies of
26 Site Organization and Site Organization's contractors and subcontractors, at any time.
27 Site Organization shall make available to City's Risk Manager or designee all books,
28 records and other information relating to the insurance coverage required herein, during

1 normal business hours.

2 Any modification or waiver of the insurance requirements herein shall only
3 be made with the approval of City's Risk Manager or designee. Not more frequently than
4 once a year, the City's Risk Manager or designee may require that Site Organization, Site
5 Organization's contractors and subcontractors change the amount, scope or types of
6 coverages required herein if, in his or her sole opinion, the amount, scope, or types of
7 coverages herein are not adequate.

8 The procuring or existence of insurance shall not be construed or deemed
9 as a limitation on liability relating to Site Organization's performance or as full
10 performance of or compliance with the indemnification provisions of this Agreement.

11 9. Site Organization shall comply with all applicable laws, rules, and
12 regulations, and the directives or instructions issued by Sponsor and the CDE relating to
13 the activities or operations conducted herein. Failure to do so may result in the
14 immediate termination of this Agreement.

15 10. Sponsor shall obtain any and all State or Federal financial assistance,
16 grants, loans of State or Federal funds, and grants or loans of State or Federal property
17 necessary to the implementation of the Program.

18 11. Sponsor retains the right to require Site Organization to replace any
19 employee or volunteer whom Sponsor determines is unsatisfactory because of personal
20 appearance, conduct or failure to properly serve the public. Sponsor shall notify Site
21 Organization in writing of such deficiencies and Site Organization shall replace the
22 employee or volunteer with a suitable employee or volunteer within forty-eight (48) hours
23 after the date of such notice.

24 12. Sponsor shall have administrative responsibility for Program
25 operations, and shall submit all reports and monitor compliance with Program
26 requirements in accordance with CDE rules, regulations, policies, and procedures as set
27 forth in 7 CFR Part 225. Site Organization shall cooperate with Sponsor, if necessary, to
28 provide information for said reports.

1 13. Sponsor and Site Organization understand and agree that this
2 Agreement is contingent upon the execution of underlying agreements with the United
3 States, the State of California, or departments or agencies thereof. Consequently,
4 neither Sponsor nor Site Organization shall have any obligation to perform, and this
5 Agreement shall have no force and effect, until and unless such underlying agreements
6 are executed. Furthermore, Sponsor may terminate this Agreement if Site Organization
7 fails to comply with any underlying agreement.

8 14. Site Organization, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers are
9 independent contractors and are not nor shall they be deemed employees or agents of
10 Sponsor. Site Organization acknowledges and agrees that a) Sponsor will not withhold
11 taxes of any kind hereunder, b) Sponsor will not secure workers' compensation or pay
12 unemployment insurance to, for or on behalf of Site Organization's employees, and c)
13 Sponsor will not provide and Site Organization is not entitled to any of the usual and
14 customary rights, benefits or privileges of Sponsor's employees.

15 15. Site Organization shall not assign its rights nor delegate its duties
16 hereunder, or any interest herein, or any portion hereof, without the prior written consent
17 of Sponsor. Any attempted assignment or delegation shall be void, and any assignee or
18 delegate shall acquire no right or interest by reason of such attempted assignment or
19 delegation.

20 16. The Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine or any other designee of
21 Sponsor's City Manager shall administer this Agreement.

22 17. All notices required or any communication desired to be given
23 hereunder shall be in writing and shall be personally delivered or deposited in the U.S.
24 Postal Service, first class, postage prepaid to the address first given herein for Site
25 Organization and to Sponsor c/o Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine, 2760
26 Studebaker Road, Long Beach, California 90815-1697. Notice shall be deemed given on
27 the date of deposit in the mail or on the date of delivery, whichever applies.

1 18. The term of this Agreement shall commence at 12:01 a.m. on June 23,
2 2014, and shall terminate at midnight on August 22, 2014, unless sooner terminated as
3 provided herein.

4 19. Sponsor shall have no liability to Site Organization if the vendor
5 supplying the food service fails to provide or delays in providing said food service.

6 20. Termination or expiration of this Agreement shall not terminate the
7 rights or liabilities of either party which rights or liabilities accrued or existed during the
8 term of the Agreement and prior to its termination or expiration.

9 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this document to be
10 executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.
