3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF
5 THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE AND LONG BEACH
6 TRAFFIC REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO PRIVATE
7 STREETS IN THE BIXBY VILLAGE AREA, PURSUANT TO
8 VEHICLE CODE SECTION 21107.5

10 WHEREAS, the Bixby Village Homeowners' Association ("HOA") owns
11 certain streets in the City of Long Beach (the "Site"); and

12 WHEREAS, the Site includes private streets that are held open for use by
13 the public for vehicular traffic; and

14 WHEREAS, these private streets are so connected to public streets that the
15 public cannot readily determine that they are not public streets; and

16 WHEREAS, HOA has requested that the City make the provisions of the
17 California Vehicle Code and the Long Beach Municipal Code related to traffic
18 enforcement applicable to these private streets; and

19 WHEREAS, written notice of a public hearing was provided to the HOA at
20 least ten (10) days before adoption of this Resolution;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
22 follows:

23 Section 1. That the above recitals are true and correct and are
24 incorporated herein.

25 Section 2. Pursuant to Section 21107.5 of the California Vehicle Code
26 and the recitals incorporated into this Resolution, it is declared that the applicable
27 provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the traffic provisions of the Long Beach
28 Municipal Code shall apply to the following named privately owned and maintained

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1 streets in the Bixby Village area owned by HOA: North Greenway, South Greenway and
2 Avenida De Castillo.

3 Section 3. The City shall not commence enforcement activities under the
4 Vehicle Code and the Municipal Code until appropriate signs have been posted or
5 caused to be posted by HOA, in accordance with applicable laws.

6 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect upon execution of the
7 Agreement by the City Manager, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this
8 resolution.

9 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City
