3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT
5 CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
7 EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR LONG
8 BEACH CITY EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION
9 OF MACHINISTS AND AEROSPACE WORKERS AND
10 UNREPRESENTED MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEES TO
11 THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
12 SYSTEM (CalPERS)

14 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
15 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or
17 agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid
18 by the employer, and reported as special compensation; and

19 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section
20 is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving
21 notice of its intention to commence reporting the value of employer paid member
22 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as
23 identified herein.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
25 as follows:

26 Section 1. Effective as of September 18, 2004, the governing body of the
27 City of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to

1 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member
2 Contributions (EPMC) for all miscellaneous employees represented by the Long Beach
3 City Employees International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM)
4 and all unrepresented miscellaneous employees. This benefit shall consist of the City
5 paying 7% of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent value
6 of compensation earnable, excluding special compensation pursuant to Government
7 Code Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The employee shall pay 1% of
8 the normal contribution.

9
10 Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
11 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.

12 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City
13 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of August 3, 2004, by


