#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive the application of LBC Beverages, Incorporated, dba Wabi Sabi Village Market, for a Person-to-Person and Premise-to-Premise transfer of an Alcoholic Beverage Control license, at 146 Linden Avenue, determine that the application serves the public convenience and necessity, submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC, and direct the City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit is granted. (District 2)

#### **DISCUSSION**

It is City Council policy to review applications for Alcoholic Beverage Control licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.

### TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) received the above application on January 21, 2015. The applicant is still in the planning stage, and has not yet received a Conditional Use Permit (CUP). City Council response is due to ABC by March 12, 2015. Provided the Planning Commission approves the CUP, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest.
