## RESOLUTION NO. RES-08-0039

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA CLEAN WATER, CLEAN AIR, SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD, PARKS, AND COASTAL PROTECTION ACT OF 2002 AND THE SAFE DRINKING WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION BOND ACT OF 2006

WHEREAS, the State Legislature enacted the Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood, Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 and the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006, which provides funds for urban forestry programs; and

WHEREAS, The State Department of Forestry and Fire Protection has been delegated with the responsibility to administer these programs and to establish procedures for applying for these funds; and

WHEREAS, the procedures require that an application for funds be authorized by resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application of the City of Long Beach requesting a grant in the approximate amount of \$162, 500 for the program known as the "Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood, Parks and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 and the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal

1	Protection Bond Act of 2006," in order to enable the City to conduct an urban forest		
2	inventory of its street trees ("Project").		
3	Section 2. The City of Long Beach has or will have sufficient funds to		
4	operate and maintain the Project.		
5	Section 3. The City of Long Beach has funds to begin implementation of		
6	the Project.		
7	Section 4. The City of Long Beach will expend funds prior to March 1,		
8	2010.		
9	Section 5. The City Manager is hereby appointed as agent of the City of		
10	Long Beach to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but		
11	not limited to applications, agreements and payment requests which may be necessary		
12	for the completion of the Project.		
13	Section 6. The City Council understands the general provisions in the		
14	application form, a copy of which is on file with the Public Works Department.		
15	Section 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption		
16	by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
