WHEREAS, several years ago the City purchased a baseball scoreboard for use at Blair Field from Trans-Lux Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine has experienced a loss of revenue, the cancellation and delaying of events due to scoreboard malfunctions; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine has already
invested approximately One Hundred and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00) for
repairs and upgrades to maintain a minimal level of service and further maintenance to
the current equipment is cost prohibitive; and

20 WHEREAS, the Trans-Lux Corporation has been unable to provide a cost 21 effective solution to the existing obsolete equipment; and

WHEREAS, the existing system needs to be upgraded and Daktronics Inc.
provides the most effective and responsive solution for the scoreboard retrofit; and

WHEREAS, Daktronics Inc. is a Sole Source, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids or seeking proposals for furnishing the equipment and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds; and

That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Daktronics Inc. for the purchase of a Prostar Video Display and baseball scoreboard and related equipment in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$447,765.00), plus a ten percent (10%) contingency if necessary.
