

RESOLUTION NO. RES-06- 0010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO PURCHASE FURNITURE SYSTEMS
THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF
FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA AND KNOLL, INC., A PARTICIPANT IN
THE U.S. COMMUNITIES GOVERNMENT PURCHASING
ALLIANCE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the
City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government
agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when
authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase furniture systems;
and

WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, Virginia has a contract for the purchase
of these items ("Fairfax Contract No. RQ01-411313-16A"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in Fairfax Contract No. RQ01-41131-16A will
facilitate acquisition of these items as well as provide considerable costs benefits to the
City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in
Fairfax Contract No. RQ01-411313-16A considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated by
this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to

1 enter an agreement with Knoll, Inc. to purchase Knoll furniture systems of substantially the
2 same type and kind offered by the Fairfax Contract No. RQ01-411313-16A pursuant to the
3 terms and conditions of Fairfax Contract No. RQ01-411313-16A except as modified by
4 mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and the vendor of these items and the
5 purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded
6 to the County of Fairfax, Virginia in an amount not to exceed \$485,000.00 including tax
7 and extras, for a period extending until the warranty expires.

8 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the
9 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
