A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PLANNING AND BUILDING TO SUBMIT TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION FOR ITS REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AND DEDICATING IN PERPETUITY CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY FOR PARK PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2003, the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopted Ordinance No. C-7894 designating and dedicating in perpetuity certain areas of the City for park purposes; and

WHEREAS, in order to certify the designation and dedication of parks in perpetuity, the California Coastal Commission has requested certain boundary changes to the maps of Marina Green Park, Rainbow Harbor Esplanade, and Long Beach Aquarium of the Pacific; and

WHEREAS, on ______, 2004, the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopted Ordinance No. _____ amending and restating the designation and dedication in perpetuity of certain areas of the City for park purposes in accordance with the California Coastal Commission modifications; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to submit the amended and restated Ordinance to the California Coastal Commission for its review as an implementing Ordinance of the Long Beach Local Coastal Program (LCP); and

WHEREAS, the City Council gave full consideration to all facts and the proposals respecting the Ordinance at properly noticed and advertised public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the proposed changes to the LCP

| 14 | Sec. 2. The Director of Planning and Building of the City of Long Beach is |
| 15 | hereby authorized to and shall submit a certified copy of this resolution, together with |
| 16 | appropriate supporting materials, to the California Coastal Commission with a request |
| 17 | for its earliest action, as an amendment to the Local Coastal Program that will take |
| 18 | effect automatically upon Commission approval pursuant to the Public Resources Code |
| 19 | or as an amendment that will require formal City Council adoption after Coastal |
| 20 | Commission approval. |

| 22 | the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution. |

ORDINANCE NO. C-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE NO. C-7894 SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING IN PERPETUITY CERTAIN LANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH FOR PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES AND USES; AND DESIGNATING IN PERPETUITY FOR PARK PURPOSES AND USES CERTAIN SITES WITHIN THE TIDELANDS TRUST BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2003, the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopted Ordinance No. C-7894 setting aside and dedicating and designating in perpetuity certain parks located in the City of Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, the California Coastal Commission reviewed and considered Ordinance No. C-7894 and has required modifications to the maps of Marina Green Park to include the adjacent public parking lot, Rainbow Harbor Esplanade to include the parking lot and walkway, and the Long Beach Aquarium of the Pacific to comprise a minimum of 23 acres, as described in the Local Coastal Program; and

WHEREAS, modifications as requested by the California Coastal
Commission have been made to the maps of Marina Green Park, Rainbow Harbor
Esplanade and Long Beach Aquarium of the Pacific that have been previously
designated in perpetuity as areas within the Tidelands Trust boundaries for public park
uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach amends and restates Ordinance No. C-7894 in its entirety and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Park Dedication.

In accordance with the goals, objectives, policies and programs of the

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Open Space and Recreation Element of the General Plan of the City of Long Beach, the following areas of the City are hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for public park purposes. Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference generally outlines the boundaries of said areas.
