Hello,

I am a resident of the 7th council district. My Wrigley Heights neighborhood is adjacent to the Oil Operators property that is the site of a proposed self-storage facility.

I would like to state my opposition to the project, <u>especially if access to the facility is allowed through my neighborhood.</u> One of the appealing features of Wrigley Heights is that there is only one access point at Wardlow and Magnolia. This limited access acts as a natural traffic controller, keeping traffic at low levels.

There is a self-storage facility at Wardlow and Long Beach, just a few minutes east. Has full capacity there been reached? What is the justification for a similar facility in such close proximity? What happened to the land at the site that the State of California purchased, to preserve it for needed park space?

A facility of the proposed type would: negatively affect the quality of life of nearby residents. reduce/eliminate desired recreational space for hiking, a dog park, play. increase traffic and congestion on Wardlow.

I have not yet read the EIR, as the web address that I was given is returning a "web site cannot be found" message. I recognize the possibility that my questions may be covered in the EIR. However, it's important to me that I share my opinion on this issue, even though I have more studying to do.
