In my August 14 budget transmittal letter, I recommended the following items be referred to Council Committees or City Manager:

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- 8. It is recommended the Council's Transportation & Infrastructure Committee be requested to review the existing Council policy linking Long Beach rates with So Cal Gas.

- 12. It is recommended that the Council's Transportation & Infrastructure Committee identify priority projects totaling \$3 million and, in addition, develop a long-term CIP funding strategy. *(amended)*

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- 20. I support the FY 1998-99 recommendations to balance the Tidelands Fund and further recommend that the Council's Tidelands & Harbor Committee be requested to develop a long-term strategy to reduce costs and expand revenues in the Tidelands area including potential private sponsorship opportunities.

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- 21. It is recommended the Council's Economic Development & Finance Committee be requested to develop additional sponsorship and advertising opportunities (in coordination with Tidelands & Harbor for the tidelands area).

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
22. It is recommended the Council's Public Safety Committee receive a report on the status of the Fire Department Strategic Plan and report its findings to the City Council.
