RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0052

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PETROCHEM MANUFACTURING, INC., ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING AS-NEEDED PREMIX R.E.A.S. SLURRY AND RELATED EQUIPMENT, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000, WITH A 20% CONTINGENCY OF \$200,000, FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$1,200,000, UNTIL THE CURRENT CONTRACT EXPIRES ON DECEMBER 31, 2022, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City requires as-needed slurry and related equipment for the repair and maintenance of City roads; and

WHEREAS, Petrochem Manufacturing, Inc. has a contract with the City of Los Angeles, California for Pre-Mix R.E.A.S. Slurry, Contract No. 59680 ("LA Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the LA Contract will facilitate acquisition

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1 of as-needed slurry and related equipment as well as provide considerable cost benefits to
2 the City; and

3 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
4 LA Contract considerably more funds would be required;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
6 follows:

7 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a
8 contract with Petrochem Manufacturing, Inc. for as-needed premix R.E.A.S. slurry and
9 related equipment, in an annual amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), with a twenty
10 percent (.20%) contingency in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000),
11 for a total annual amount not to exceed of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
12 (\$1,200,000), until the Los Angeles Contract expires on December 31, 2022, with the
13 option to renew for as long as the Los Angeles Contract is in effect and at the discretion of
14 the City Manager.

15 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
16 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
