FIFTY-THIRD AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS FIFTY-THIRD AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of September 10, 2018 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 83 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
 - "83. HOUGHTON PARK AREA LIGHTING.
- 83.1 Scope of Work. WS shall reconfigure Houghton Park lighting circuitry, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "EEE" and incorporated herein.
- 83.2 Compensation. For the services and work related to reconfiguring Houghton Park lighting circuitry, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$14,120).
- 83.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,

shall apply to reconfiguring Houghton Park lighting circuitry."

2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to reconfigure the park area lighting circuitry due to new building construction. Below is a description of the work:

CLP will furnish labor, material and equipment to trench in three locations, approximately 300' total, install 1%" conduit, #8 THHN conductor, pullboxes and energize the area lighting circuit (ADF001). Additionally, CLP will de-energize the circuit that feed the poles removed within the construction fencing.

Total cost for this work is Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$14,120).

Exclusions:

- Restoration of landscape.
- Repair to existing damaged conduit/conductor.
- New conduit/conductor feeding parking lot and area lights remove for construction (AP 1006, AP1010, AP1011, AP1030, AP1061 and AP1077).
