A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE OFFICE FURNITURE FROM ALLSTEEL, INC. THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN STATE OF CALIFORNIA MULTIPLE AWARD SCHEDULE (CMAS) FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase office furniture from AllSteel Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) has a contract for the purchase of office furniture under Contract No. 4-01-01-0060A ("State Contract"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the State Contract will facilitate acquisition of office furniture as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the State Contract, considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated hereby by this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with AllSteel Inc. to purchase office furniture of the same type and kind

purchased by the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) pursuant to the State Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and AllSteel Inc. and the purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 (which includes tax) plus an additional 2% of that base amount if needed for unforeseen expenses, for a period extending until the warranty on these items expires.

Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
