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SECOND AMENDMENT TO LEASE NO. 27279

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO LEASE is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 8 , 2005, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on February 18, 2003, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("Tenant"), and EDWIN WHITE, an individual ("Landlord").

- 1. <u>RECITALS</u>: This Second Amendment is made with reference to the following facts and objectives:
 - 1.1 The parties entered into Lease No. 27279 as of June 14, 2001 (as amended, the "Lease") whereby Tenant leased certain premises ("Premises") from Landlord for use as a neighborhood police center;
 - 1.2 The parties entered into a First Amendment to Lease No. 27279 as of February 4, 2003 whereby the parties amended the term of the Lease, among other things; and
 - 1.3 Landlord and Tenant now wish to further amend the Lease as follows:
- , 2. Section 4 is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:
 - "4. Term/Termination. The premises are leased to Tenant for a period of five (5) years commencing on May 1, 2001 and expiring on April 30, 2006. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the Federal Community Development Block Grant Funds awarded to Tenant are eliminated or reduced the Tenant shall have the right to terminate this Lease upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Landlord."
