THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34147 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of December 5, 2017 for reference purposes only, pursuant to Resolution No. RES-15-0146 adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on November 17, 2015, by and between OFFICE DEPOT, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business located at 6600 North Military Trail, Boca Raton, Florida 33496, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH ("City"), a municipal corporation.

WHEREAS, Section 1802 of the Long Beach City Charter permits the City to make purchases under the purchasing contracts of other governmental agencies when authorized to do so by a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Region 4 Education Service Center through The Cooperative Purchasing Network has a contract for the purchase of custodial supplies, Contract No. R5120 ("TCPN Contract"); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. RES-15-0146 authorizes the City to purchase custodial supplies by virtue of the TCPN Contract; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 34147 (the "Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide City with custodial supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term an additional one (1) year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1.D of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "D. The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on January 4, 2016, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on January 3, 2019. The Parties have the option to extend the term one (1) additional one-year period. In the event the

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underlying Agreement expires prior to the renewal term, Contractor will enter into a new Agreement with substantially similar terms and conditions."
