RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys and walkways in the City of Long Beach in connection with the conduct of the 2015 Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) Long Beach ePrix. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The 1st Annual FIA Long Beach ePrix will be held in Long Beach April 5, 2015. This event is anticipated to attract over 75,000 people to the City. In order to allow for the staging of this event, a Resolution has been prepared, which provides for the temporary closure of a portion of Shoreline Drive between Ocean Boulevard and Pine Avenue, and adjacent streets, alleys and walkways. This area will be used as part of the venue for the festival, which will also be held on the Marina Green and at Rainbow Lagoon Park. Additional space is required for the safety of event attendees due to projected attendance figures.

Access to the Shoreline Marina and Shoreline Village will be via Alamitos parking lot and Marina access road. Directional signage shall be provided to clearly direct traffic to these areas. The appropriate City Departments have reviewed the requested closure plans.

Traffic management and signage plans shall be shared with the public through various media outlets.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard Anthony on June 17, 2014 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 18, 2014.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on July 1, 2014, to expedite the execution of the Resolution in time for the event, which is scheduled for closure from April 3 through April 5, 2015.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS AND WALKWAYS IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 2015 FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE L'AUTOMOBILE (FIA) LONG BEACH ePRIX

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the conduct of the 2015 FIA Long Beach ePrix on the streets of the City of Long Beach and the coverage thereof by the media provides a unique opportunity for the City of Long Beach to publicize and call attention to the City, its natural advantage, resources, enterprises, attractions, climate and facilities.

Section 2. For the conduct of the 2015 FIA Long Beach ePrix, the following streets, alleys, and walkways are hereby temporarily closed for the periods stated:

A. From April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to eastern end of Seaside Way, Linden Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Locust Avenue to Collins Way, Atlantic Way from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Hart Place to eastern end, Linden Avenue, northbound and southbound from Shoreline Drive to Marina Parking lot, Locust Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Bay Street at Pine Avenue, and The Paseo at Pine Avenue.

- B. From April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., Shoreline Drive from Ocean Boulevard and Alamitos intersection to Pine Avenue.
- C. From April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., Shoreline Village Drive from Marina Parking lot to Shoreline Drive.
- D. On April 3 and 4, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Pine Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Upper Esplanade.
- Section 3. The temporary closing of the above streets, alleys, and walkways, for the times herein provided is necessary for the safety and protection of the participants and spectators in the 2015 FIA Long Beach ePrix and qualifying events to be held from April 3, 2015 through April 4, 2015, utilizing the streets described herein.
- Section 4. For the period April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.A. are hereby withdrawn and removed from public use.
- Section 5. For the period April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.B. are hereby withdrawn and removed from public use.
- Section 6. April 3, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. to April 5, 2015 at 12:01 a.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.C. are hereby withdrawn and removed from public use.
- Section 7. On April 3 and 4, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.D. are hereby withdrawn and removed from public use.
- Section 8. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to post notices of the intent to temporarily reduce lanes, close the streets, alleys, walkways and portions of the promenade described in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 above at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closure thereof.
 - Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
