

RESOLUTION NO. RES-06-0116

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AND TO
ENTER AN AGREEMENT AND ALL AMENDMENTS WITH
THE CALIFORNIA RESOURCES AGENCY FOR FUNDING
UNDER THE WATER SECURITY, CLEAN DRINKING
WATER, COASTAL AND BEACH PROTECTION ACT OF
2002 FOR A CALIFORNIA RIVER PARKWAYS GRANT TO
DEVELOP THE DEFOREST WETLANDS

WHEREAS, the State of California provides grants to public entities under
the California River Parkways Grant Program ("Program") of the Water Security, Clean
Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002 ("Act"); and

WHEREAS, the State Resources Agency ("Agency") has the responsibility
for administration of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Agency requires that the applicant for grant funds approve
submission of the application by resolution; and

WHEREAS, if a grant is given to the applicant, the applicant must enter an
agreement with the Agency for the Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
authorized to apply for funding under the Program for the development and construction
of the DeForest Wetlands ("Project").

Sec. 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations
and execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications,

1 agreements, amendments, payments requests, and other documents which may be
2 necessary to complete the Project with funding through the Program.

3 Sec. 3. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have sufficient
4 funds to operate and maintain the Project after it is completed.

5 Sec. 4. The City of Long Beach certifies that it will comply with the provisions
6 of California Labor Code Section 1771.8 regarding payment of prevailing wages on the
7 Project.

8 Sec. 5. The City of Long Beach certifies that it understands the assurances
9 and certification in the application form.

10 Sec. 6. The City of Long Beach certifies that, if applicable, the Project will
11 comply with any laws and regulations including but not limited to building codes, health and
12 safety codes, disabled access laws. The City further certifies that, prior to commencement
13 of construction, it has obtained all applicable permits for the Project.

14 Sec. 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the
15 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
