15	Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002 ("Act"); and
16	WHEREAS, the State Resources Agency ("Agency") has the responsibility
17	for administration of the Program; and
18	WHEREAS, the Agency requires that the applicant for grant funds approve
19	submission of the application by resolution; and
20	WHEREAS, if a grant is given to the applicant, the applicant must enter an
21	agreement with the Agency for the Program;
22	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
23	follows:
24	Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
25	authorized to apply for funding under the Program for the development and construction
26	of the DeForest Wetlands ("Project").
27	Sec. 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations
28	and execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications,

agreements, amendments, payments requests, and other documents which may be
 necessary to complete the Project with funding through the Program.

3 Sec. 3. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have sufficient
4 funds to operate and maintain the Project after it is completed.

Sec. 4. The City of Long Beach certifies that it will comply with the provisions
of California Labor Code Section 1771.8 regarding payment of prevailing wages on the
Project.

8 Sec. 5. The City of Long Beach certifies that it understands the assurances9 and certification in the application form.

Sec. 6. The City of Long Beach certifies that, if applicable, the Project will
comply with any laws and regulations including but not limited to building codes, health and
safety codes, disabled access laws. The City further certifies that, prior to commencement
of construction, it has obtained all applicable permits for the Project.

Sec. 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the
City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.


