WHEREAS, on November 3, 1992, and on November 5, 1996, the people of Los Angeles County enacted Los Angeles County Proposition A, the Safe Neighborhood Parks, Gang Prevention, Tree-Planting, Senior and Youth Recreation, Beaches and Wildlife Protection Initiative (the "Proposition"), which provides funds to public agencies in the County for the purpose of developing facilities for public recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Proposition also created the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District (the "District") to administer said funds; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application for the acquisition and development of projects along the Los Angeles River in the City of Long Beach, including: (a) Deforest Wetland Development; (b) Drake/Chavez Greenbelt; (c) Wrigley Greenbelt; and (d) Baker Street Mini-Park; and

WHEREAS, the funding was originally allocated to the Mountains
Recreation & Conservation Authority (the "Authority"), which has assigned its rights
thereunder, including the right to submit this application, to the City of Long Beach in a
resolution attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

12	Section 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to conduct all		
13	negotiations, accept all funds, execute and submit all documents including but not limited		
14	to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and all other documents		
15	which may be necessary for the completion of the Project, and implement and administer		
16	the funds and all things related to the Project.
