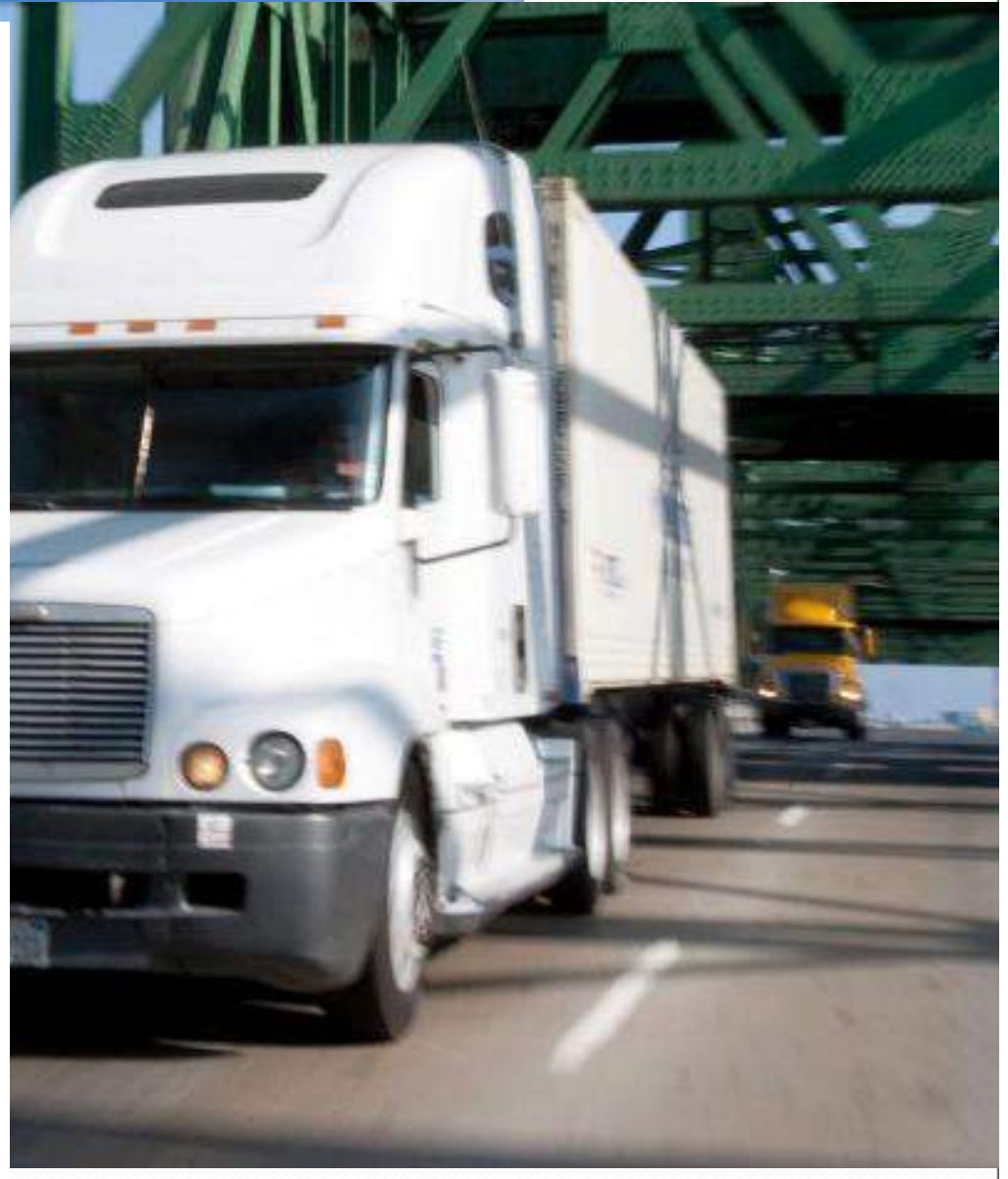
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Clean Truck Program



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- About 8,260 trucks meet 2007 emission standards
- 90% of truck trips are considered “clean”
- About 790 trucks are natural gas fueled (9% of container trips)



Shore Power Implementation



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- POLA Evergreen terminal shore power construction is complete
- POLB SSA Pier C terminal shore power construction nearly complete
- Commissioning is scheduled for Summer 2010

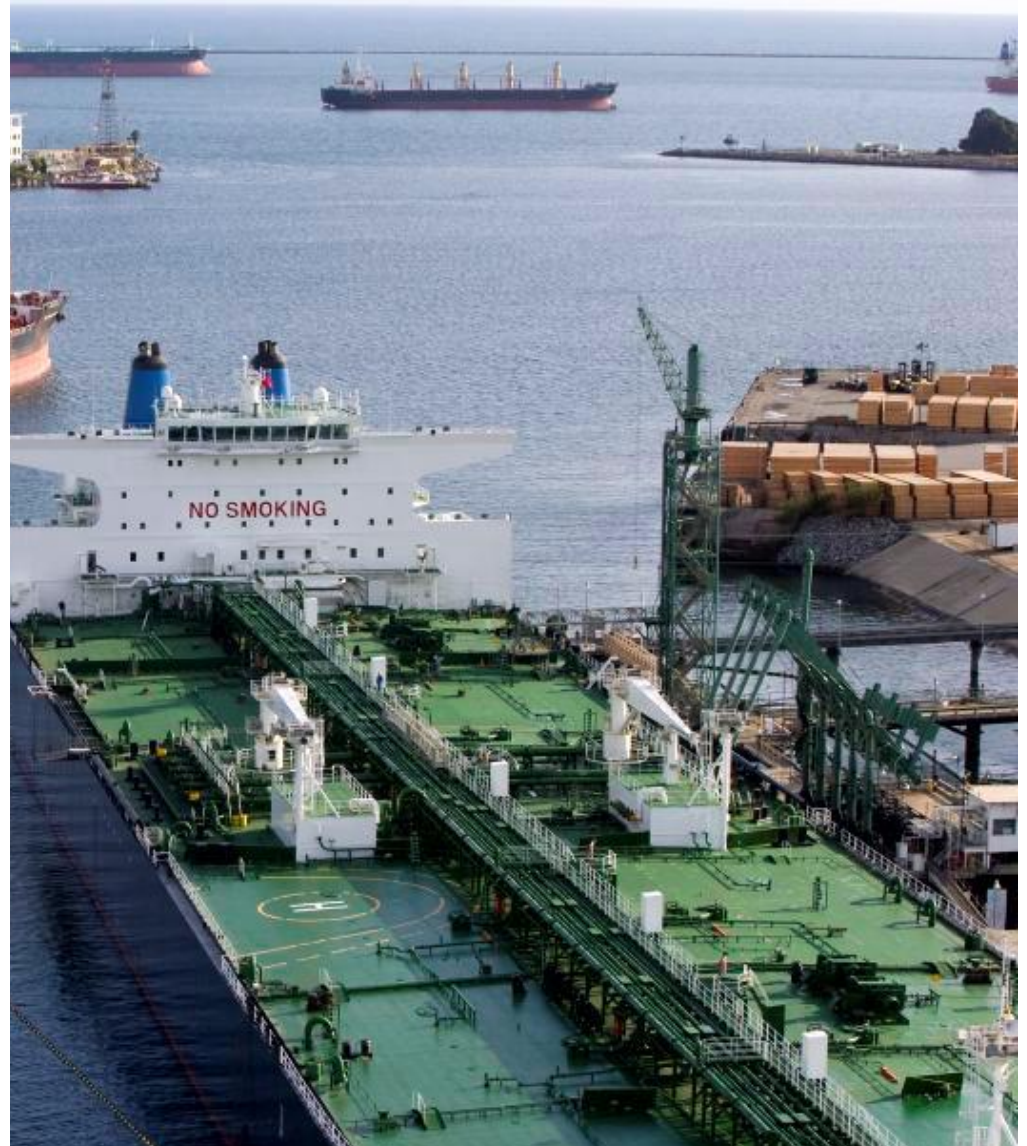


Vessel Speed Reduction



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- POLB compliance is 96% at 20 nautical miles and 74% at 40 nautical miles
- POLA compliance is 91% at 20 nautical miles and 60% at 40 nautical miles



Pacific Harbor Line



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- Each port's Board of Harbor Commissioners approved a Third Amendment to their respective Operating Agreements with PHL.

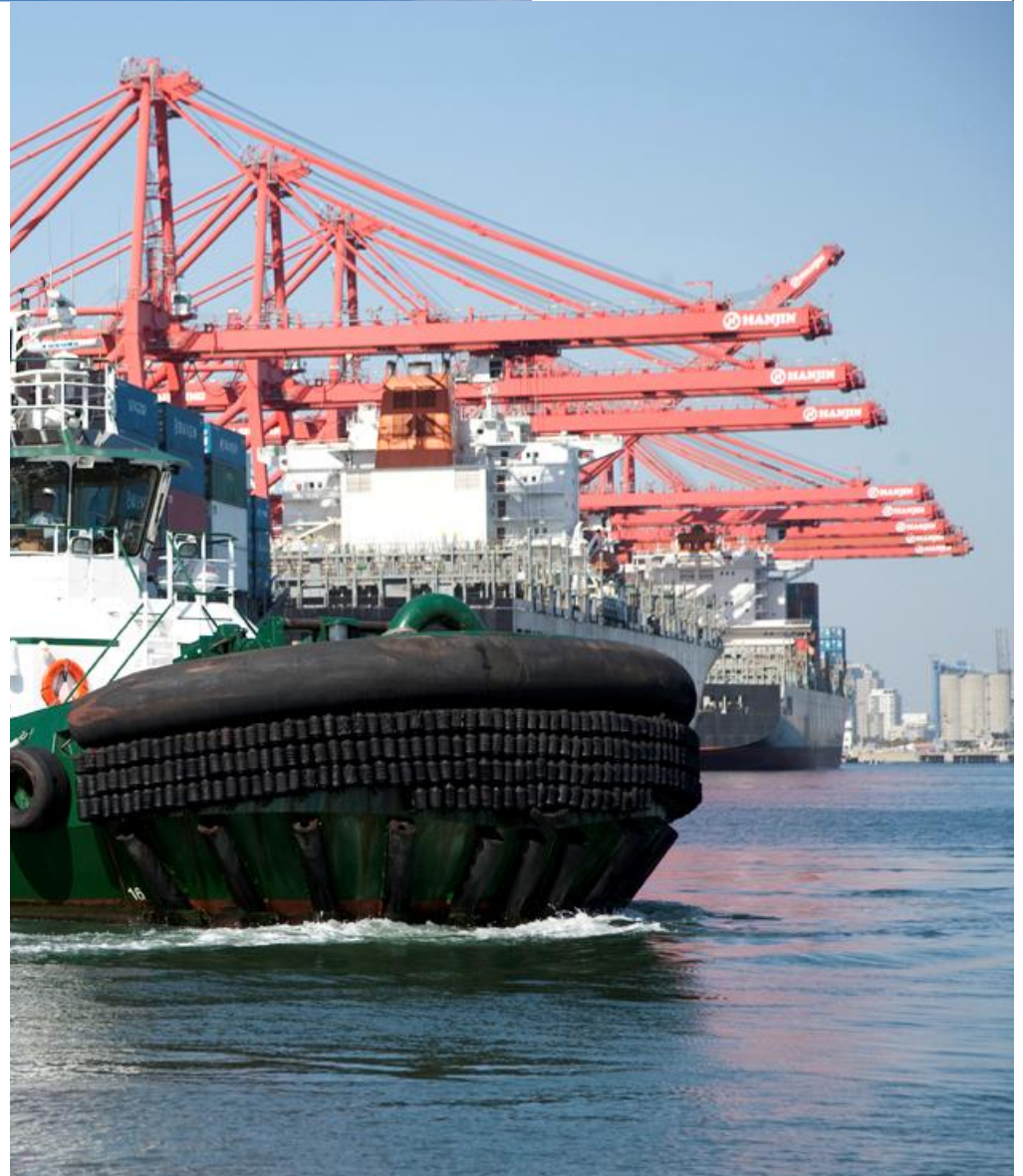


Technology Advancement Program



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- Emissions testing for the Foss hybrid tugboat underway
- First of three prototype hybrid yard hostlers was delivered
- Funding approved for emissions testing of Rypos diesel particulate filter

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- Each port's Board of Harbor Commissioners approved the 2009 Emissions Inventories (June 2010)



CAAP Awards Program



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- CAAP Air Quality Awards ceremony recognizes outstanding achievements of port tenants and operators
- Five companies received 2010 CAAP Awards



Grant Awards



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- POLB received a \$1.6 million grant in March from the U.S. EPA under the National Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Program
- Funds will be used to retrofit and/or repower 4 pieces of cargo-handling equipment and to repower 3 harbor craft
