## RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0120

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN SUPPORT OF THE FEDERAL DREAM ACT

WHEREAS, each year 65,000 undocumented students who have lived in the United States for over five years, graduate from American high schools; and WHEREAS, many of theses students face overwhelming obstacles in

accessing and completing higher education due to their immigration status; and

WHEREAS, the Development, Relief and Education for Alien Minors ("DREAM") Act, introduced in the U.S. Senate, would permit high school graduates who immigrated to the United States before the age of 16, lived in the country for at least five consecutive years prior to the passage of the legislation and are under the age of 30 at the time of enactment, the ability to gain conditional legal residency; and

WHEREAS, the conditional residency is furthermore contingent upon the good moral character of the students and the completion of either two years post-secondary education or military service within the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has already invested in the education of these students and believe they should be allowed to reach their full potential and contribute to our society; and

WHEREAS, meaningful access to higher education through the provision of loans and work-study to eligible students would allow these students to make a full contribution to the country's and the City's civic, political and economic well-being; and

WHEREAS, passage of the DREAM Act would lead to an increase in educational opportunities for our youth and in the number of young, educated and hardworking adults capable of contributing to the local community and economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
