Furthermore, request the City Manager to work with the City Health Officer and various Departments to present recommendations on how to safely restart the Long Beach Neighborhood Clean-Up Assistance Program and other neighborhood improvement programs that have been discontinued due the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Communications and outreach plan informing residents of their special refuse collections,
- Creation of an Inter-agency plan for Right-Of-Way maintenance
