1 City shall not exceed \$350,000.00, per contract year, provided, however, that if City  
2 receives additional funds under the Prime Contract, then this Subcontract may be  
3 amended to increase City's disbursements to organization. City shall disburse the funds  
4 payable hereunder in due course of payments following receipt from Organization of  
5 monthly billing statements in a form approved by City for the preceding month, and  
6 conditioned on the City's receipt of the monthly progress report from Organization.

7 B. The City shall have no obligation to pay Organization until and unless City  
8 receives monthly progress reports that summarizes Organization's performance under this  
9 Subcontract during the immediately preceding month, and that describes Organization's  
10 progress in providing the services stated in Exhibit 'A' and Exhibit 'A-1'.

11 C. City's obligation to pay Organization arises only after receipt of funds from  
12 the County under the Prime Contract.

13 D. Organization shall submit invoices on a monthly basis. Organization shall  
14 prepare and submit monthly invoices within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of the  
15 month in which services were provided. Attached to each invoice shall be documentation  
16 to support the invoiced amounts. Failure to submit a completed invoice with proper back-  
17 up documentation may result in late payment of the invoice. The City reserves the right  
18 to refuse payment of invoices received sixty (60) days after the services were provided."

19 2. Except as expressly amended in this First Amendment, all terms and  
20 conditions in Subcontract No. 29347 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full  
21 force and effect.

Family Preservation Base Rate Services include In-Home Outreach Counseling visits, clinical direction, and the Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC). Family Preservation Supplemental Services include Child Focused Activities, Child Follow-up Visits, Counseling Services, Drug Testing, Emergency Housing, Parenting Training Services/Fatherhood Program, Substance Abuse Assessment and Treatment, Substitute Adult Role Model Services (SARM), Teaching and Demonstrating Homemaker Services (T&D), and Transportation Services. Subcontractor will provide all services in compliance with requirements in the Prime Contract and the Family Preservation Program Statement of Work (Exhibit A-2 of the Prime Contract). Subcontractor will be responsible for all related administrative functions, including but not limited to: all required case documentation and reporting, Family Preservation Archive data collection and data entry, staff training and supervision, Auxiliary Fund requests, and quality assurance activities.
