ADVANCE Women's Program (A.W.P.)

A comprehensive housing program designed to meet the needs of homeless women veterans. The program provides a safe and sober living environment for 30 female veterans and 5 non-veteran women.

ADVANCE Women with Children's Program

A transitional housing program for veteran women with children. The program provides a safe and sober environment for families. The program offers 9 family units for women with 1 or 2 children.

Veterans In Progress (V.I.P.)

A residential 90-day work re-entry program for unemployed, homeless veterans that have a minimum of 60 days clean and sober if referred from a substance abuse treatment program. If self-referred, 90 days clean and sober are required.

Veterans Re-Entry Project (V.R.P.)

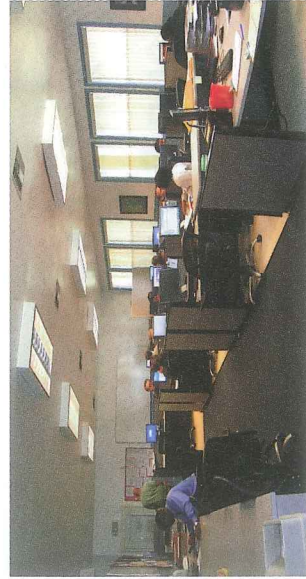
A residential program for OEF/OIF veterans returning from combat with P.T.S.D.

Veterans Village Recovery Center (V.V.R.C.)

This is a 34-bed, 30 to 90 day residential substance abuse treatment program for veterans, operated by the Long Beach VA Medical Center.

Career Center

Internet Access, Telephones, Fax Machine, Printer, Copy Machine, Voice Message Service, Computer Classes, Etc.

Other Housing Options:

Veterans must be clean and sober and will enter a tenant landlord agreement. Must show an ability to pay rent and be clinically cleared.

Transitional Housing (L.B.S.H.)

Veterans will have their own room in a shared living facility with case management.

Cabrillo Plaza Apartments

Studio apartments for homeless veterans.

Century Villages at Cabrillo (C.V.C.)

Veterans who are receiving stable sources of income but have large debt.

Permanent Housing for the Disabled (P.H.D.)

See below.

Shelter Plus Care

P.H.D. and Shelter + Care are for homeless disabled veterans who suffer multiple and chronic disabilities that are significant barriers to self-sufficiency.

Social Independent Living Skills (S.I.L.S.)

Veterans that have a disability with significant barriers to obtaining employment and need assistance in developing skills necessary for independent living.
