## DISCUSSION

The Department of Financial Management denied the business license application of Phillina Has, DBA Phillina's Beauty Shop and Supplies, 1001 E. Pacific Coast Highway, \#109, at the recommendation of the Planning and Building Department on the basis of not submitting plans and obtaining permits and inspections for two new spa pedicure chairs to include new plumbing (see Attachment A). The business has appealed this decision in a letter dated November 28, 2005 (see Attachment B).

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) prescribes that the applicant can appeal the denial of a business license application to the City Council within ten days of the denial. Whenever it is provided that a hearing shall be heard by the City Council, the City Council may, in its discretion, either conduct the hearing itself or appoint a hearing officer to conduct the hearing.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on December 7, 2005.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

LBMC requires that the hearing be set at its next regular meeting or within ten days of receiving the appeal.
