**Recommended Conditions for ABC License:**

Application of Rainbow Rocket Incorporated, dba Rainbow Rocket,  
for an original on-sale general for boat alcoholic beverage license  
at 200 Aquarium Way B, Dock

This is an original application for On-sale General for a boat license. The location in the Downtown Shoreline Marina. A determination of public convenience and necessity is not required and there is no possible basis for a protest on this license. We are requesting the following conditions be attached to mitigate any problems with the license.

1. All beverages offered for sale at the premises shall be displayed and available for convenient inspection and purchase within the premises by the general public.
2. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the boat or equipment and the area adjacent to the licensed premise over which they have control.
3. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the boat or equipment or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
4. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent loitering of persons.
5. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained on the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the boat when inside the Marina.
6. Licensee shall not offer or permit or provide any type of live entertainment except as allowed by a valid Entertainment Permit issued by the city of Long Beach.
