About the Job Program Pilot

- Goal is to serve 30 participants
 - 15 via cohort model (Willow Springs Park Wetlands)
 - 15 via other worksites
- Partnership with DHHS (MSC), Goodwill, and continuum of care partners
- Transportation, hot meals, onsite Job Coach, & support
- Transition from part-time, temporary paid work experience to permanent full-time employment & housing



Participants Served

Since July 2020:

- 10 cohort participants
 - 1 pending
- 2 non-cohort (other worksites pending)
 - Meals on Wheels, Salvation Army

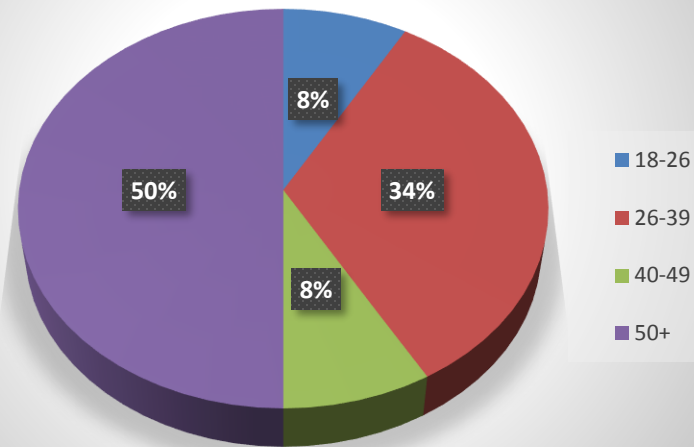
Pre-COVID:

- 5 participants served prior to March 2020 (various worksites)

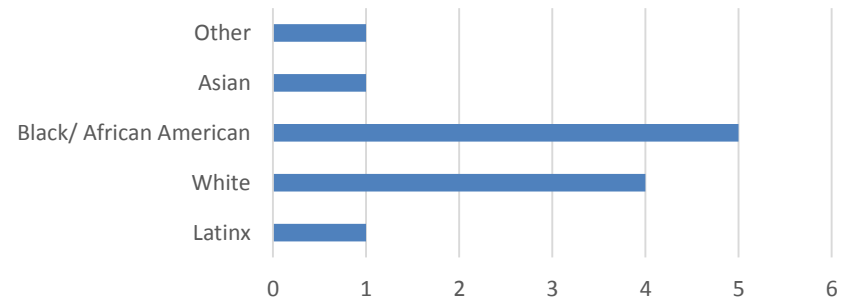


Participants Served

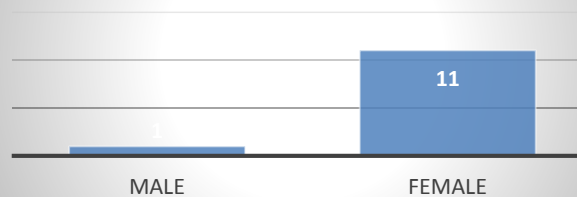
Age Scale

- 2nd Cohort – August 31, 2020
 - 4 women started, 1 pending
