Flight slot allocations:

At month-end, Long Beach Airport had 41 allocated Air Carrier flight slots - JetBlue (31), US Airways (4), Allegiant (3), Delta (1), FedEx (1), UPS (1) and nine allocated Commuter Carrier flight slots - Delta (5), Alaska (4).

Sixteen Commuter Carrier flight slots remain available for allocation.

Definitions:

Total Passenger Traffic - Total number of airline passengers both enplaned (departures) and deplaned (arrivals).

Air Carrier - A scheduled passenger or cargo airline, certificated under FAR Part 121, 125 or 135, with a maximum takeoff weight of 75,000 lbs or over.

Commuter Carrier - A scheduled passenger or cargo airline, certificated under FAR Part 121, 125 or 135, with a maximum takeoff weight under 75,000 lbs.

Air Cargo – Cargo carried by aircraft, both inbound and outbound.
