1 SIXTIETH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

3 THIS SIXTIETH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of
4 March 6, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City
5 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and
6 between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY
7 LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH,
8 a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP
10 agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

11 WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could
12 choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

13 WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided
14 in the Contract;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions
16 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

17 1. Section 92 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as
18 follows:

19 "92. LED CONVERSION - RIDESHARE PARKING LOT AT THE LONG
20 BEACH AIRPORT.

21 92.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment for
22 the LED conversion in the rideshare parking lot at the Long Beach Airport to remove and
23 dispose of sixteen (16) existing 250W HPS cobra head fixtures and replace them with
24 138W LED cobra head fixtures, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto
25 as Exhibit "MMM", and incorporated herein.

26 92.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the LED
27 conversion at the rideshare parking lot at the Long Beach Airport, City shall pay WS upon
28 completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Five

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1 Dollars (\$6,255).


2 92.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions
3 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,
4 shall apply to the LED conversion at the rideshare parking lot at the Long Beach Airport."

5 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions
6 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and
7 confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.



RE: Rideshare Parking Lot Lighting

Mr. Garrett,

City Light & Power, Inc. is pleased to submit a proposal to install light emitting diode (LED) cobra head light fixtures or relamp the existing high pressure sodium (HPS) cobra head light fixtures located in the rideshare parking lot at the Long Beach Airport. A detailed description of both options is listed below.

- **Option 1-LED Conversion:** Remove and dispose of (16) existing 250W HPS cobra head fixtures and replace with 138W LED cobra head fixtures. Once the fixtures are converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the fixtures are working properly.
 - o Total cost for Option 1 is Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$6,255)
- **Option 2-Relamp:** Remove and dispose of (16) 250W HPS lamps and replace with new 250W HPS lamps. Once the lamps are replaced, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the lamps are working properly.
 - o Total cost for Option 2 is One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,750)

Notes/Exclusions:

1. There will be energy savings with the LED option.
2. Pricing for conversion/relamp only. No additional repairs included.
3. Any additional repairs required will be invoiced on a T&M basis after approval to proceed is granted.
4. Proposal valid for 30-days.
